The ocean goes on for miles and miles.

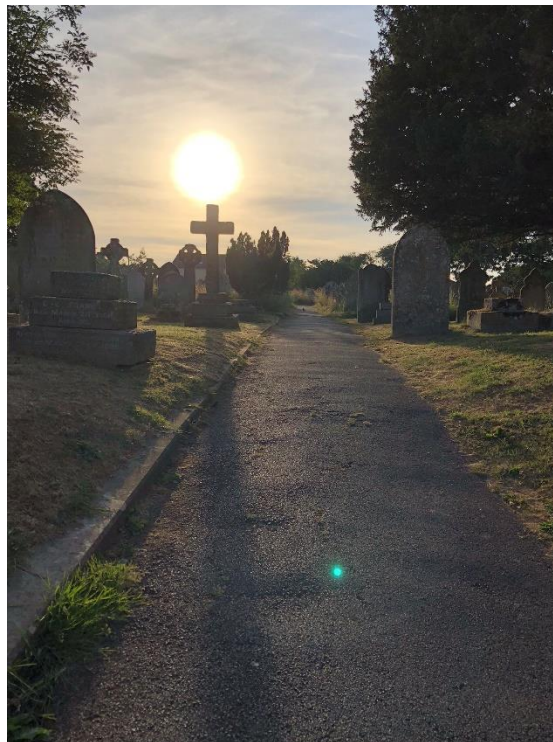
