

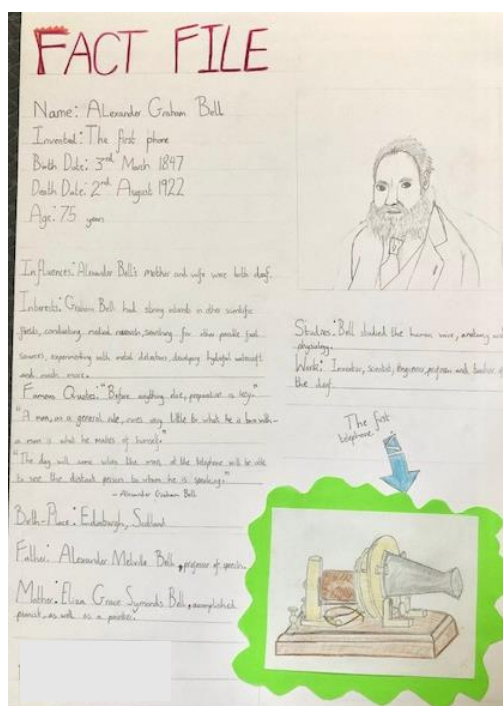

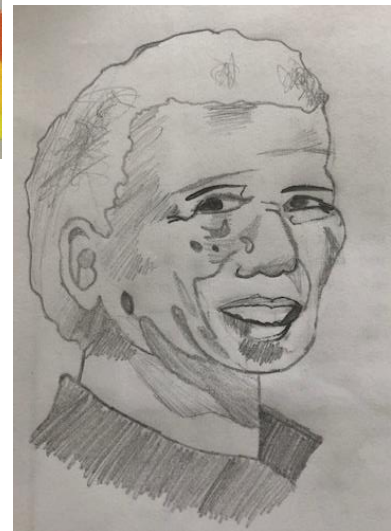
I've been learning all about the Solar System
