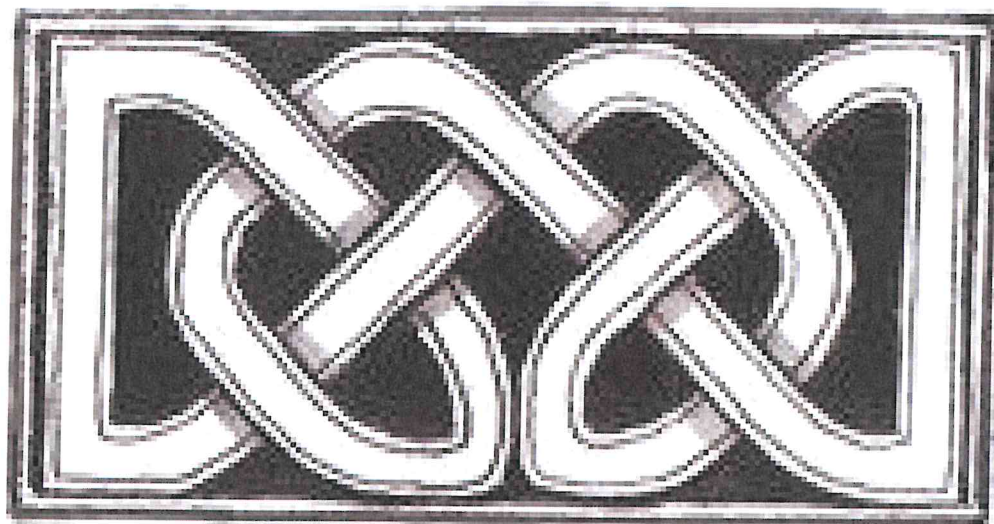
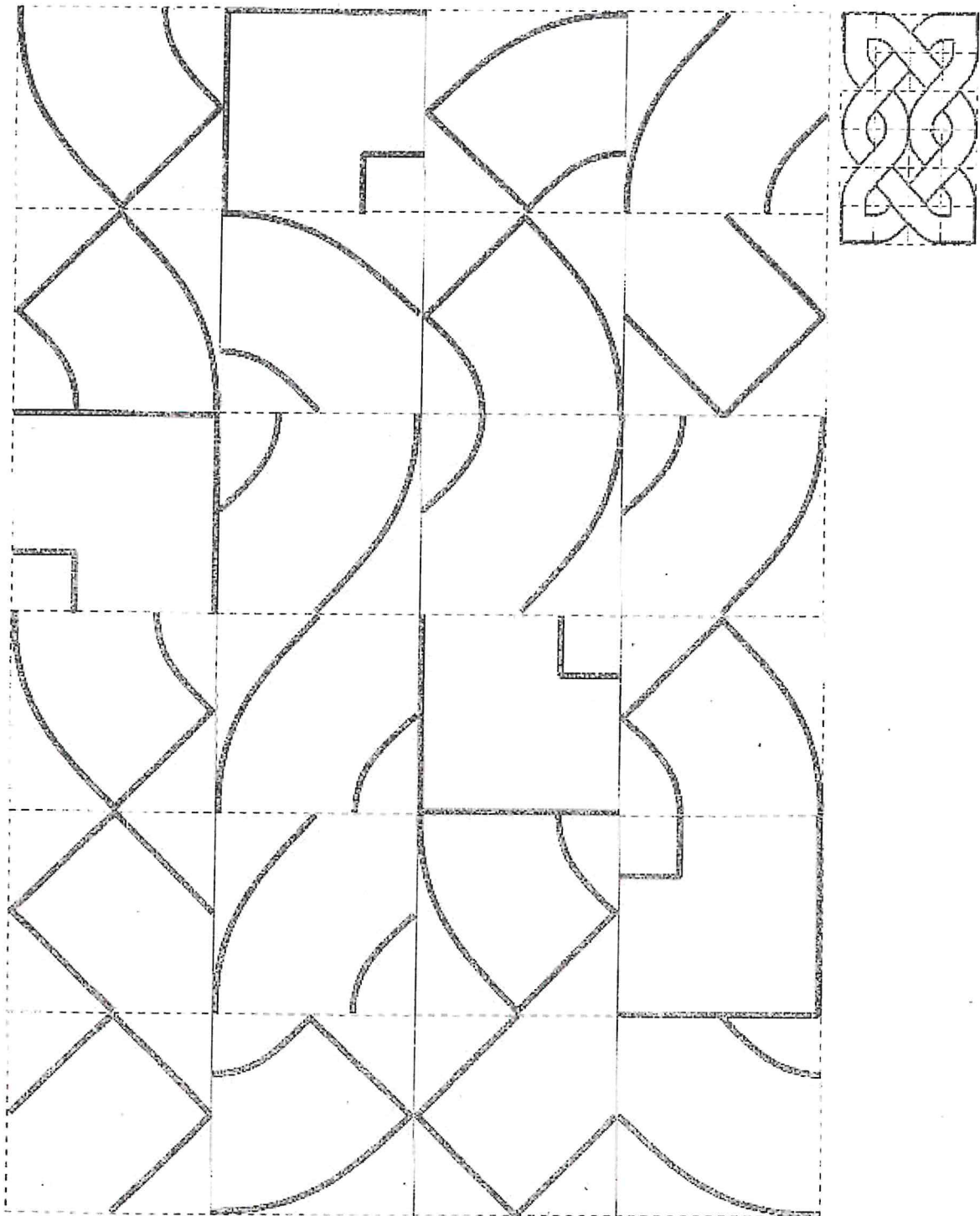

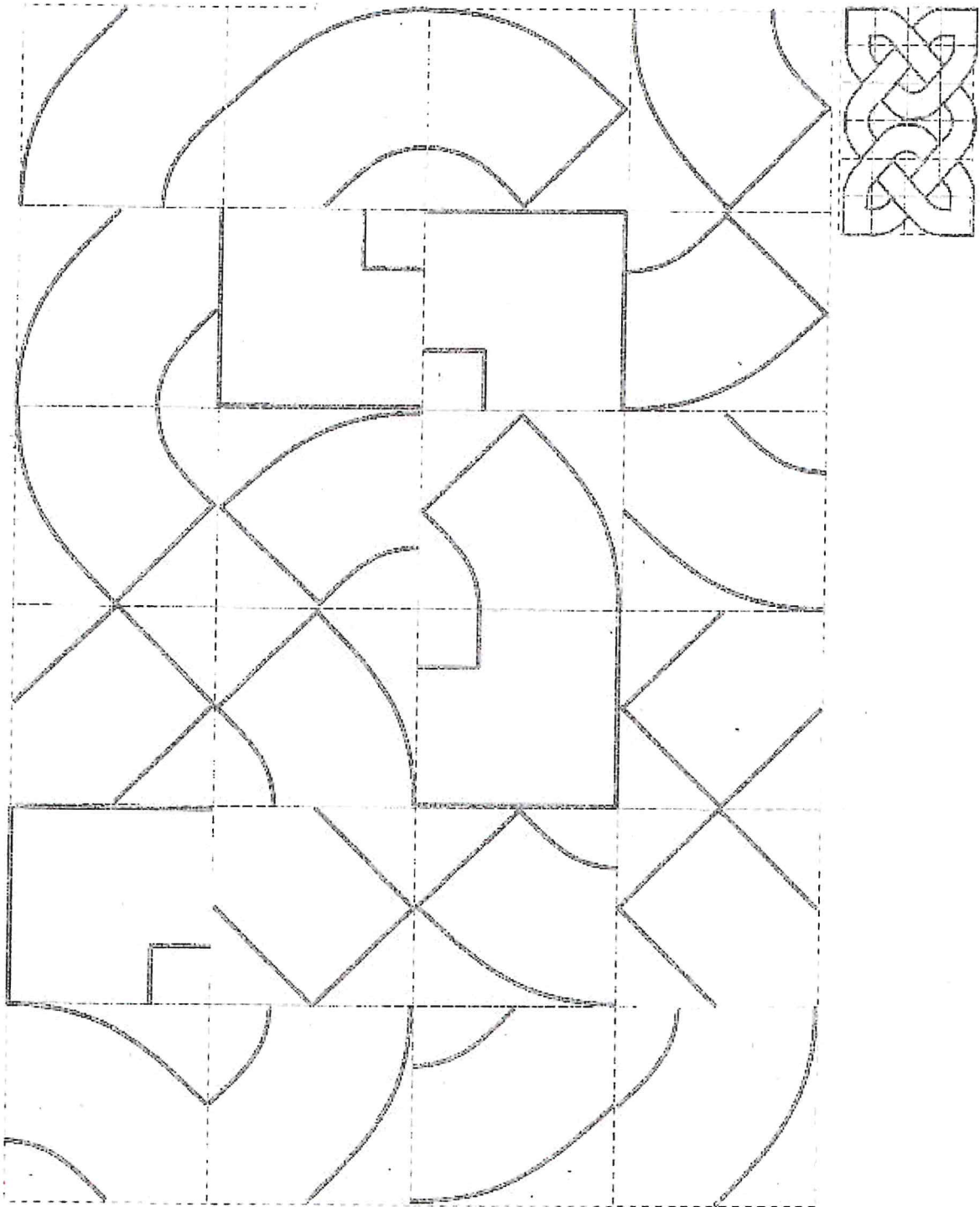
Celtic design 1

Cut out the squares below, then join them to make the design in the top corner of the sheet.



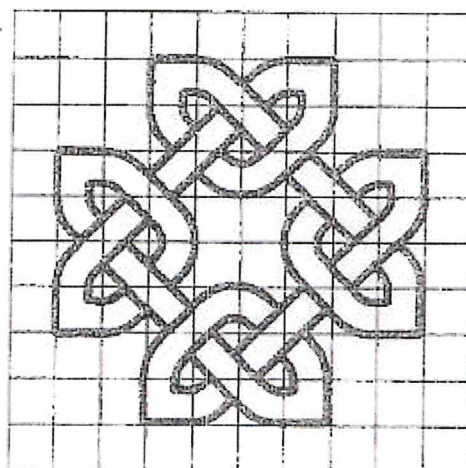
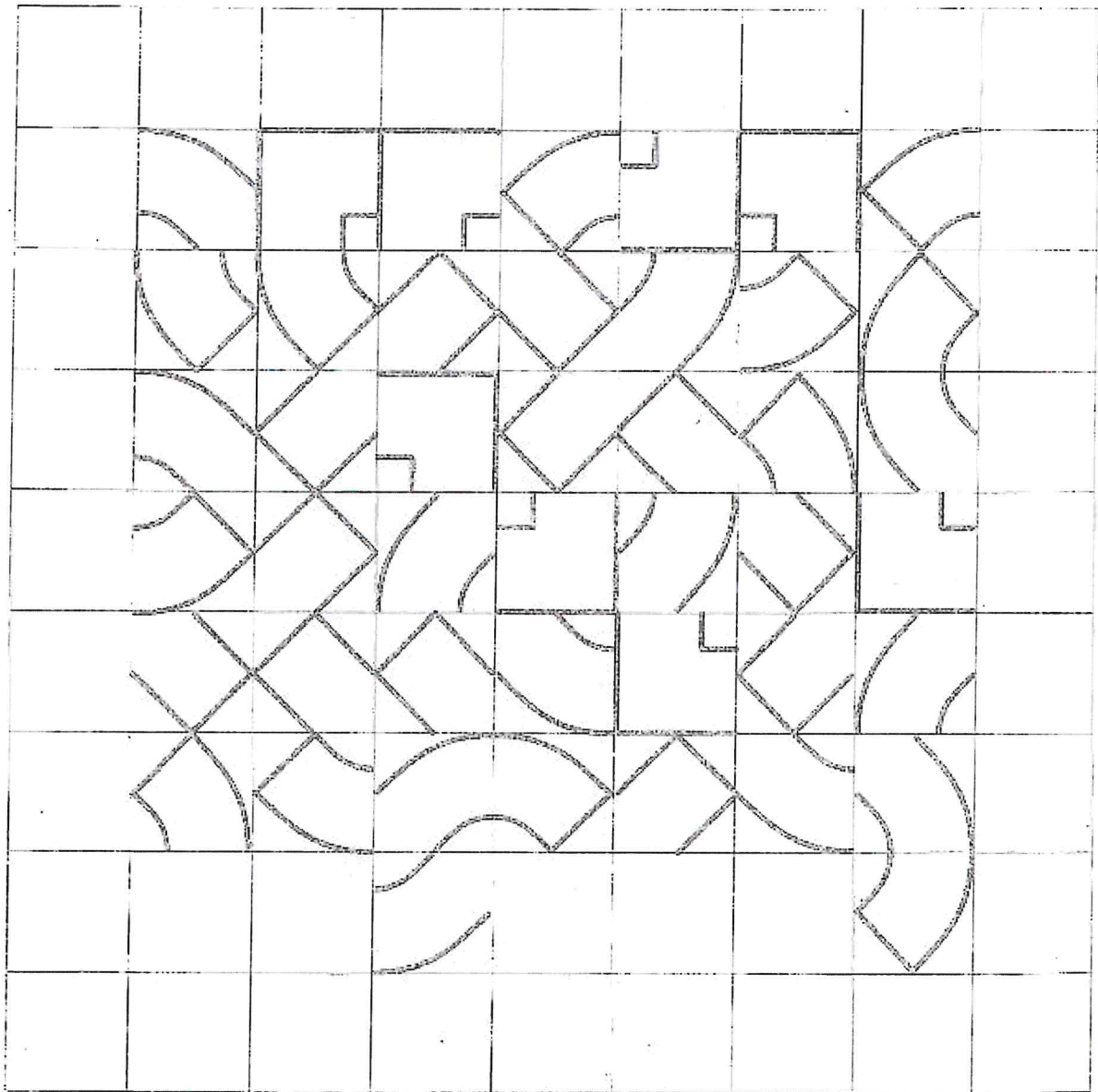
Celtic design 2

Cut out the squares below, then join them to make the design in the top corner of the sheet.

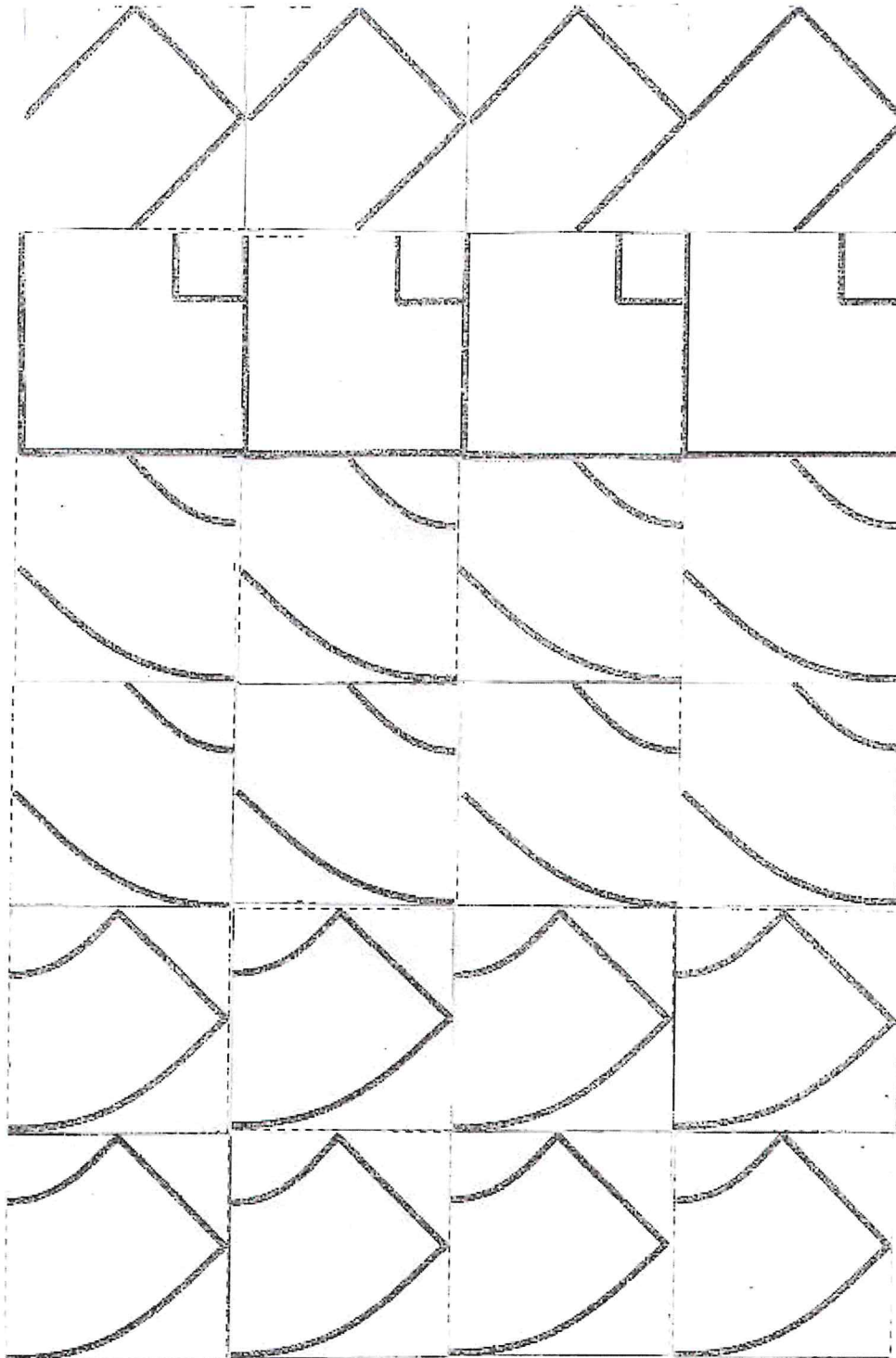


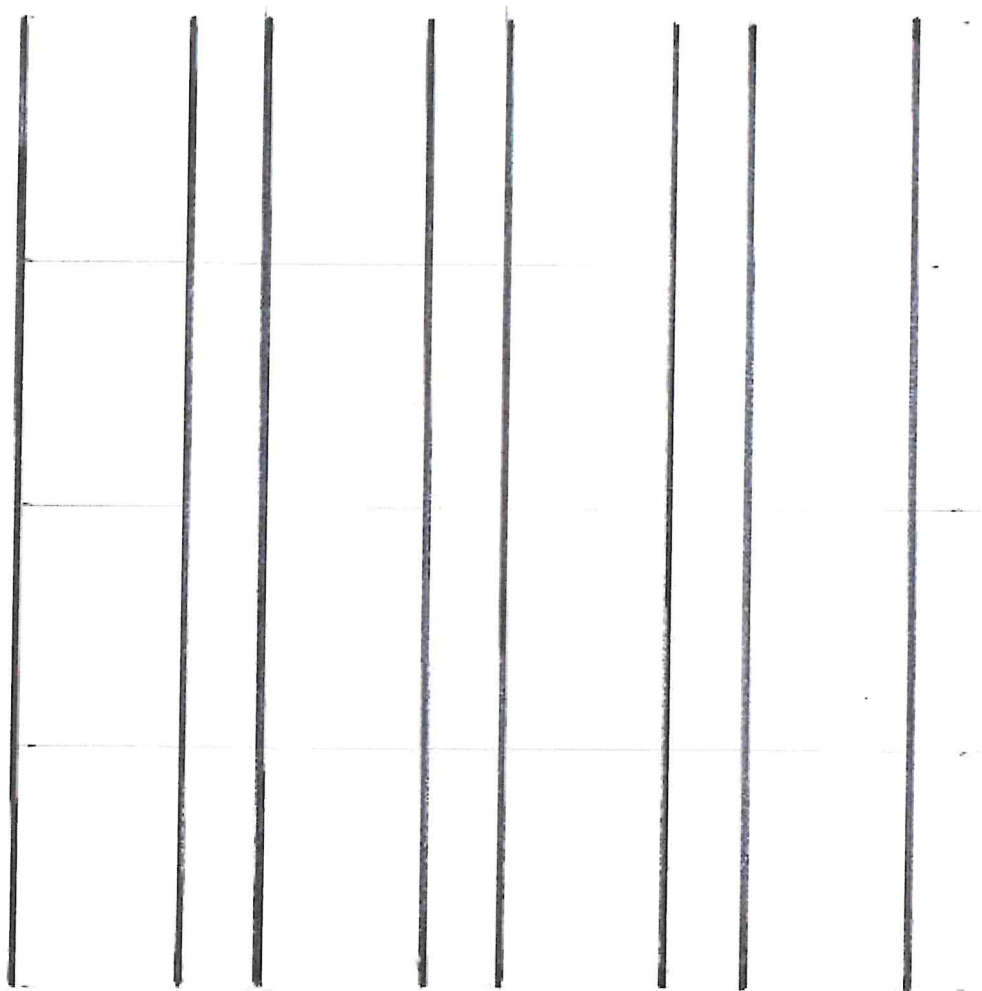
Celtic design 3

(including the empty squares).

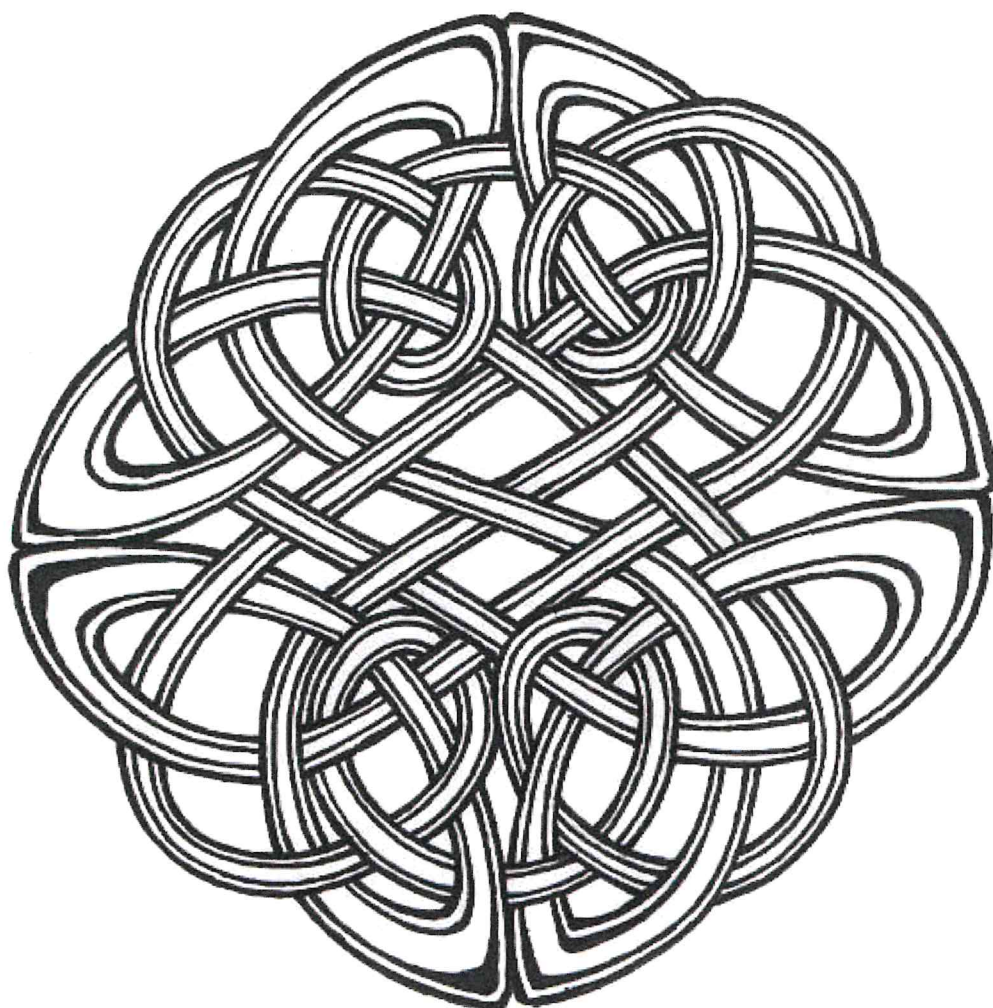
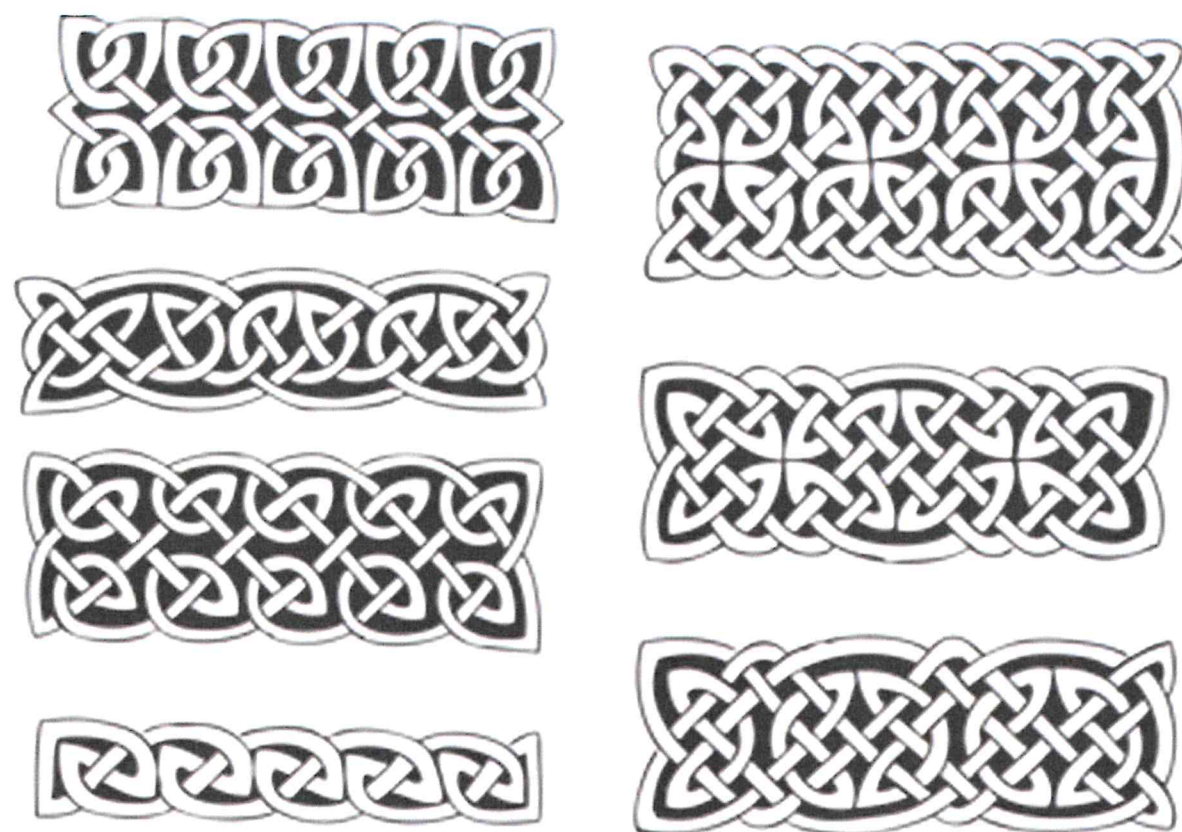

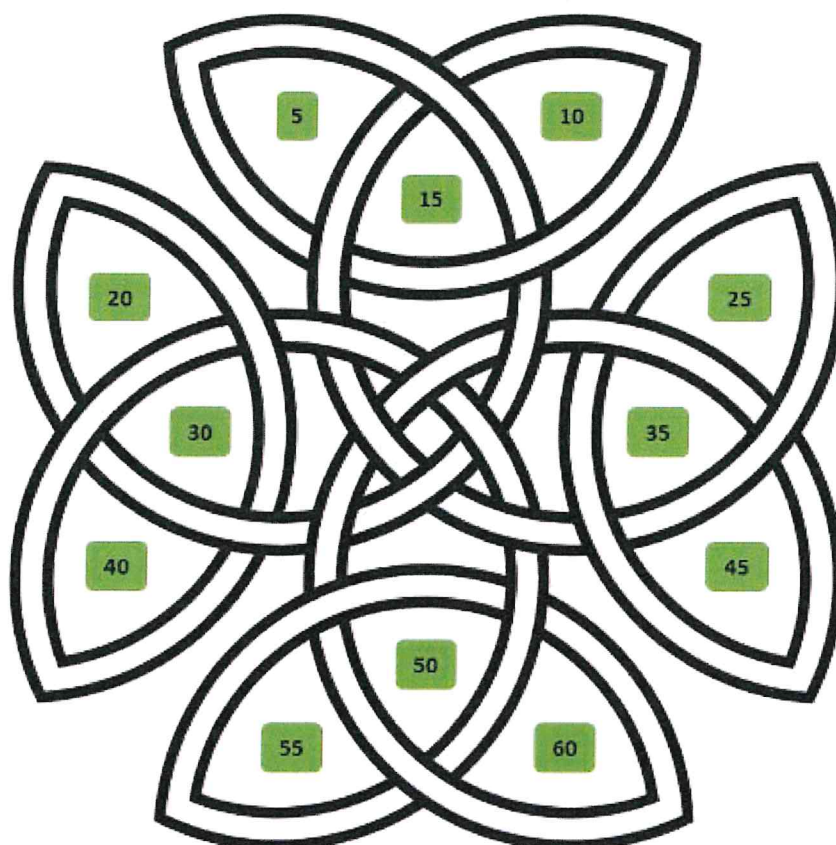




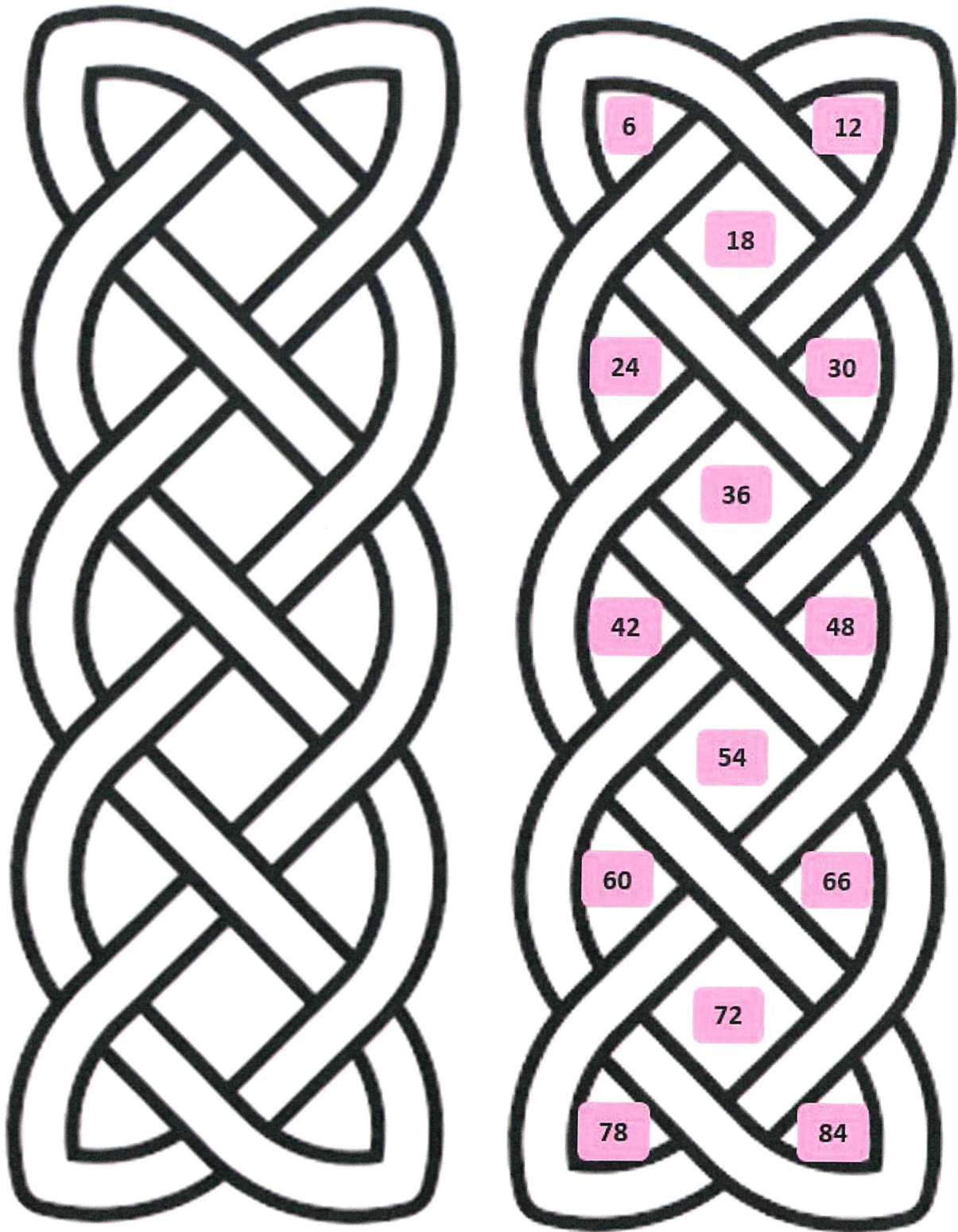
Celtic knots tables practice 7 'regions'
